

## Graduate Assistantship for 2018-2019 Economic and Public Policy Focus

The Kem C. Gardner Policy Institute invites applications for a graduate assistant position for the 2018-2019 school year. The position is open to graduate students from departments and programs within the College of Social and Behavioral Science.

The graduate assistant will work on applied research, policy analysis, and economic impact analysis.

The position requires a 20-hour per week commitment during Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 semesters. Compensation will be \$15,500 (\$7,750/semester) and up to a 100% tuition waiver. The tuition waiver does not cover special fees nor does it cover differential tuition. Other limitations may apply and we encourage student to discuss those with their advisor.

The graduate assistant must be enrolled full-time (9-12 credit hours) for both semesters in a graduate degree program within the College of Social and Behavioral Science. An excellent academic record and solid grounding in the administration of government, public policy and/or economics are desired. Graduate assistants must maintain a GPA of 3.0 of higher during the 2018-2019 academic year.
